

My Health Record: A Patient's Journey through the ED



Max presents to the Emergency Department after a fall at home. On arrival at triage, he's met by Claudia, the ED nurse.

MHR Checkpoint

Claudia accesses Max's My Health Record. She's able to verify his **personal details, GP and next-of-kin** with information stored within the record.

MHR Checkpoint

Alvin views Max's My Health Record during the assessment. He finds a recent **shared health summary** outlining Max's past medical history, and checks the **medicines information view** to view what drugs Max takes.



Alvin (the ED registrar) is on duty today. He's now ready to see Max in a patient bay for an initial assessment.



Because Max takes Warfarin and is confused, Alvin thinks a set of bloods and a CT scan is required following the fall.

MHR Checkpoint

Alvin reviews the **pathology reports** section of Max's My Health Record. He discovers that Max had some bloods taken yesterday to monitor his INR.

MHR Checkpoint

Sally can see from the recent **prescribing and dispensing records** what medications have been dispensed from the community pharmacist. She's able to use this information to confirm a current medication list with Max's wife.



Luckily, the CT looks clear. Max and his wife then get a visit from Sally, the ED Pharmacist. Sally thinks a review of Max's medications is warranted after the fall and undertakes a medication reconciliation.



After Sally completes the medication reconciliation, it's almost time to go home. Brendan (the ED nurse) sees Max before he's ready to be discharged from the department.

MHR Checkpoint

Brendan organises Max's discharge medications and inputs the necessary information into the ED clinical information system. Max's **discharge summary** is uploaded to his My Health Record, ready for the GP to review at his follow up next week.
