Standard precautions

Standard precautions must always be used when caring for all patients, regardless of their infection status



Perform hand hygiene



Use aseptic technique



Perform routine environmental cleaning



Use personal protective equipment (PPE)*



Use and dispose of sharps safely



Handle and store waste safely



Use respiratory hygiene and cough etiquette



Clean and reprocess reusable patient equipment



Handle and store linen safely

*When used as part of **standard precautions**, PPE protects against probable exposure to blood and body substances. When used as a part of **transmission-based precautions**, PPE serves as a barrier to specific means of transmission of infectious agents.
