

# **Intrathecal**


#### Bags with additives (and large syringes)



Fluid name, batch number, expiry date and bag graduations to remain visible after label placement.

Complete 'diluent' prompt if fluid name not visible.


#### Syringes (and small bags with additives)



Graduations on syringe scale to remain visible after label placement.

'Flag' label for smaller syringes.

### Catheter (line) label / Route



Label near the injection port on the patient side.
